## RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE USE OF THE ROTHER'S MILLS OUTDOOR TERRACE AND FOUNTAIN

These rules and regulations set out the detailed conditions for the use of the Rother's Mills outdoor areas. The area is made available for public use on a daily basis for leisure and recreation purposes. Everyone should behave in such a way that they do not endanger or harm others. In order to assure order, neatness and peace, and, above all, the safety of all persons on the terrace area, **IT IS FORBIDDEN**:

- to disturb the peace and public order, including listening to loud music, in particular with vulgarisms,
- 2. to behave aggressively, use physical and verbal violence,
- 3. to leave children under 13 years of age unaccompanied,
- 4. to bring hazardous materials, flammable materials, pyrotechnics and other dangerous substances onto the terrace,
- 5. to be in an intoxicated state or to consume alcoholic beverages outside a designated and marked area,
- 6. to bring in or use intoxicants or to be under their influence,
- 7. to smoke tobacco products and electronic cigarettes, except in designated and marked areas,
- 8. to litter and pollute the entire area,
- 9. to damage the terrace elements, the fountain, the building and the greenery,
- 10. to enter the fountain, to bathe, to wash or to drink the water from the fountain,
- 11. to ride bicycles, scooters, skateboards, roller skates, etc. on the terrace,
- 12. to run on the terrace, to jump on the fountain elements, to climb on the building elements,
- 13. to tamper with the fountain jets, electrical installations and equipment and other technical components located in the outdoor area of the Mills,
- 14. to bring animals without a leash onto the terrace,
- 15. to display the signs, advertisements, inscriptions, stickers or notices.

Access to the outdoor areas may be temporarily restricted due to technical work and the organisation of events.
